

## **Sermon Questions**

### **Luke 18:18-27**

This week we discussed one of life's most important questions, "How can I inherit eternal life?" Human beings were created differently than anything else in God's creation. We were created in His image, which is why asking the question about life after death is essential to what it means to be human. The truth is that God wants you to know how to have a relationship with Him and wants you to be in relationship with Him. My encouragement to you is to listen to the message this week and respond to the good news that Jesus Christ wants a relationship with you.

### **Questions**

1. Why is it important to ask questions about eternal life? How confident should you be about having a personal relationship with God?
2. Why did Jesus say only God is good? How is our definition of goodness flawed? Why do we often compare ourselves to others rather than to God?
3. Why did Jesus start by sharing some of the 10 Commandments? Which commandments did He share? How many had the rich young ruler broken? How many have you broken?
4. Did the rich young ruler admit to breaking all the commandments? How did he answer? Why was he deceived in his answer? Why was it imperative for him to understand he was a sinner? Why is Jesus only able to save people who understand they are sinners?

5. How did Jesus Christ expose the reality of His heart? How has God been exposing the reality of your heart? What would be the one thing Jesus would tell you that you still lack? Why is it important that you are aware of this area? How is avoidance of this area hindering your relationship with Jesus Christ?
6. If Jesus loved the rich young ruler then why was the rich young ruler sad when Jesus told him to go and sell everything he had and distribute it to the poor and then come and follow Him? What gets in the way of your “full-followership” of Jesus Christ?
7. How hard is it for someone to go to heaven based upon their own merits? If no one can save themselves, then how can someone be saved?
8. Do you believe in the exclusivity of salvation through the person and work of Jesus Christ? Explain.
9. Have you repented and trusted in Jesus Christ alone for your salvation? When?
10. What is your personal testimony of salvation? Have you ever written it out? Have you ever shared it publicly? If not, then why not write and share your testimony with someone this week?
11. What was your greatest insight from this week’s message? What application do you need to immediately make in your life?
