Three Critical Confessions Matthew 16:13-20

<u>Iesus Christ</u> is **<u>LORD</u>** (13-17)

The Church is invincible (18)

The kingdom is comprehensive (19-20)

Questions

- 1. What was the first question of Jesus to His disciples? How was this a non-threatening question? What were the people saying about Jesus?
- 2. Once Jesus heard the disciple's answer to his question, what was His next question? Why is responding to this question the most important in life? Who do you personally say Jesus is?
- 3. How does Peter respond to the question of Jesus? What is Jesus' response to Peter? Who revealed the true identity of Jesus Christ to Peter? What is the significance of God at work in salvation?

- 4. What is a confession? What does it mean to confess that Jesus Christ is Lord? Why is this so important?
- 5. What does Jesus promise Peter that He will do? What is the church? Who is building the church? Who does the church belong to? What is the purpose of the church?
- 6. How should we talk about the church? Why? What is the significance of our how we treat the bride of Christ? If you are a husband, would you ever let anyone talk about your wife the way some people talk about the church?
- 7. What other vehicle of ministry has God promised to bless? Why is the church so important? How has Jesus Christ demonstrated His love for the church?
- 8. Have you ever talked bad about the church? A pastor? An elder? Why is repenting from this sin so important?
- 9. What does it mean that the kingdom is comprehensive? Why is this an essential confession? What does it look like to experience the visible manifestation of God's comprehensive rule in our lives? Where does God want His kingdom to extend?
- 10. What are some of the manifestations of the kingdom? Does God still forgive sins? Heal? Free from demonic influence?
- 11. How have you applied these three critical confessions? How essential are they in your life?
- 12. What are some of the things in the future of BRAVE Church that encourage you? How is God asking you to be involved with your time? Gifts? Resources?
- 13. Do you give financially on a regular basis? Do you serve on a regular basis? Is church attendance a priority on a regular basis? What changes do you need to immediately make?
- 14. Where is God's prompting in your life right now? What do you need to do to follow that prompting?
- 15. What has been your biggest take-a-way from the message? What are you needing to apply in your life right now?
