

Should be **demonstrated** through your **personal belief** in Jesus Christ as Lord. [1-2]

Can be **validated** by the **physical resurrection** of Jesus Christ from the dead. [3-11]

Would be **devastated** if the resurrection of Jesus Christ **proved false**. [12-19]

If the resurrection of Jesus Christ didn't occur:

1. Christ is still dead.
2. Preaching would be pointless.
3. Believing in Christ would be nuts.
4. All preachers are liars and the Word of God is false
5. Faith means nothing because you are still dead in your sins.
6. Those who died are either just "worm food" or eternally damned.
7. Feel sorry for Christians! Pity us!

Who preached the gospel to you by which you gained an understanding of the gospel?

What arguments have you heard from those who deny the resurrection of Christ?

Why do these arguments not hold up under scrutiny?

Do you have family members, friends, classmates or work associates who deny Christ's resurrection?

Do you think any of the evidence for Christ's resurrection would help convince them?
